Attached is an overview of this term's topic and subject content. Throughout this term, your child will be learning about the topic Groundbreaking Greeks which focuses on Ancient Greece.

- **PE:** This half term, the children will have PE on a **Monday and Friday**. Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on these days. For girls with earrings, these must be either removed or covered for PE sessions. We cannot provide plasters to cover earrings, these must be brought in to school. Please note that PE days are likely to change each half term- but we will keep you updated!
- **Homework:** Homework will also be given out on Fridays and due back in on Wednesdays. This will include maths, English, and Science.
- **Reading:** Children should bring in their reading book(s) and yellow diary every day. We will continue to encourage children to read for pleasure as much as possible and there will be time in the school day for children to quiz on what they have read. Children are also welcome to borrow a library book from our class Library.
- Children need to bring in their own **water bottles** with them so they can have a drink throughout the school day. These are available to purchase from the Office for a small cost.
- **Jodrell Bank trip-** The trip will take place on **Tuesday 25h February**. Please remember that if we do not receive enough contributions by the **4th February**, then we reserve the right to cancel this trip.
