I hope that you all had a lovely, relaxing Summer break. The children definitely needed some time to rest and recharge their batteries for our next half term. It is due to be an exciting one! Here are some key bits of new information and some reminders for this half term:

Attached is an overview of this terms first topic and subject content. Throughout this term, your child will be learning about the topic Dynamic Dynasties which focuses around the Shang Dynasty.

- **PE:** This half term, the children will have PE on a **Thursday and Friday**. Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on these days. For girls with earrings, these must be either removed or covered for PE sessions. We cannot provide plasters to cover earrings, these must be brought in to school. Please note that PE days are likely to change each half term- but we will keep you updated!
- **Homework:** Homework will also be given out on Fridays and due back in on Wednesdays. This will include weekly spellings and a rotation of Maths and English. Year 5's topic homework for this half term is to create a 3D dragon, linking to our topic of Dynamic Dynasties.
- **Reading:** Children should bring in their reading book(s) and yellow diary **every day**. We will continue to encourage children to read for pleasure as much as possible and there will be time in the school day for children to quiz on what they have read.
- Children need to bring in their own **water bottles** with them so they can have a drink throughout the school day. These are available to purchase from the Office for a small cost.
