Welcome Back!

We hope you have all had an amazing Easter break! Here are a few important bits of information for the upcoming term:

Our new topic is 'School Days', where we will be learning the history of our school, and the key events in it's past to create a timeline. We will then begin to learn about life in the Victorian era, and how different being a child would have been compared to our lives today. Please see the topic web for further information on other subjects and topics being studied this term.

This half term we will be working on Target Games in PE on a Monday and Athletics with Bee Active on a Friday. **Children need to come to school in PE kit on Mondays and Fridays.**

Homework will be given out on a **Friday** and is due back in on the **following Wednesday**. This will include a range of Maths, English and topic. Please continue to send your child with their reading book every day. Reading books and diaries will be changed and checked on a Wednesday each week. Please read at home as much as possible with your child and sign their reading diary every time your child reads. The reading target and expectation is at least 4 times weekly and your child will move up on the aiming high reading chart each time they read and could earn a prize at the end of the half term.

The **Year 1 Phonics Check** will take place at the beginning of Summer 2 so anything you can do at home to help will give your child an advantage on passing. Practise words and sounds can be found on phonics play and completed electronically.
