Welcome back to a new year at Goldenhill! We are looking forward to lots of exciting learning this term and of course lots of fun too!

Homework will be given out on Thursdays. It is due to be handed in by the following Wednesday.

Children do not require a pencil case. All equipment needed will be provided by school.
