To celebrate the Coronation of King Charles III on 6th May, we will be carrying out a range of activities on Friday 5th May, these will include; creative writing- to be put into a time capsule, producing portraits of King Charles III, exploring 'sports through time' facilitated by Bee Active and exploring chronology through the production of timelines of the Monarchy.

Weather permitting; we are hoping that all classes will have our usual lunch provision outdoor.

To help with the Coronation festivities, children are allowed to come into school on Friday 5th May in red, white and blue for the whole day. In return for wearing non-uniform, we request a donation of cakes.

After our morning activities on Friday 5th May we will continue, in the afternoon, with a Coronation Party, which we would like to invite parents, grandparents, aunties, uncles and any other relatives that you would like to invite along.

The party will commence at 2.30p.m. in the school playground, entrance is free to everyone. You will be able to collect your child/children at 2.30p.m, from your child's normal classroom door, so that everyone can create lifelong memories together.

A barbeque will be available selling hotdogs and burgers alongside cold drinks and cakes. There will also be a bouncy castle, raffle and live music from our academy Rock Bands.
