Dear Parent /Carer

Re: Follow-up height and weight checks involving Year 1 pupils.

During 21/22 the National Child Measurements Programme visited all Local Authority Primary schools to measure the height and weight of pupils in Reception.

In addition to the required delivery of the NCMP programme, the local authority signed up to take part in a further research study MapMe, supported by NCMP and led by a research team from Newcastle University. Details about the study and how to withdraw your child from the MapMe study were included in last year's NCMP parental information letter.

As part of this study, the NCMP team would now like to return to re-measure the height and weight of children who were measured last year in **Reception** and who are now in **Year 1**. Children will be re-measured fully clothed, except for their coat and shoes, in a private space away from other pupils. This re-measurement programme will take place between January and June 2023.

Result letters will not be forwarded to parents and measurements will not be shared with your child, other children or school staff. If you would like to obtain your child's results please contact the NCMP team directly on 01782 234267 or email ncmp@stoke.gov.uk

Your child will NOT be Re-measured if:

- You opted out of the NCMP programme and your child was not measured in Reception.
- You opted out of the MapMe study in 2021/22.
- Your child was absent at the time of the NCMP school visit and was not measured in Reception.
- The school that your child attended in Reception was not located in Stoke-on-Trent.
