

Science

In Science, we will be learning all about seasonal changes which take place between winter and spring. We will measure the weather in a range of ways, using specialist equipment such as a rain gauge. We will learn about why certain animals and plants thrive at certain times of year, and will begin to understand the idea of day length.

Computing

Children will use Purple Mash to create their own animated stories, then we will learn all about coding.

History

In History, children will be learning all about the reign of Queen Elizabeth II. We will also learn about the events of the Great Fire of London, why they happened, how they could have been prevented, and the impact that this has had on London today. We will be comparing today's firefighting to the tools London would have had back then!

Geography

The children will learn about the 4 countries of the UK, and their capital cities. We will spot human and physical geographical features, and learn about compass directions.

PE

PE this half term will be on Mondays and Thursdays. Miss Woodward will teach us to improve our throwing on a Monday, and on Thursdays we work with Bee Active on Health Related Education.

RE

In our RE unit, we will learn all about Judaism. We ask the question, who is Jewish and what do they believe? We learn about special events and traditions in the Jewish calendar and compare this with what we know about Christianity.

Maths

We will continue to develop our understanding of number and place value within 20. We will then move on to addition and subtraction, working with number to 20. Then the children return to number, but expand their understanding to numbers within 50.

English

During this term, the children will retell the story of Katie in London. We will describe characters and settings from the story. Then, we will move on to the Great Fire of London, when we will write recounts from the perspective of Samuel Pepys and some amazing fire poetry, full of exciting adjectives.

DT

In DT, children will be creating their own moving windmill- fit for a mouse in old Amsterdam.

Art

In Art we will learn all about the work of Stephen Wiltshire, and his special talent of drawing from memory. We will use his techniques to draw some famous landmarks of London.
