Behaviour Pathways – Frequently Asked Questions:

What are Behaviour Pathways?

They are a clear 0–6 stepped system showing how behaviour is supported and addressed across school.

What is Pathway 0?

This is where we want all children to be — focused, respectful and ready to learn. This is recognised and celebrated.

What is Time-In?

Time-In is a restorative reflection period used instead of traditional detention. It allows children to reflect, repair relationships and reset.

When will parents be contacted?

Parents will be contacted when behaviour reaches higher pathways (typically Pathway 4+), involves aggression, or where safeguarding is involved.

Is the system the same for every child?

No. Behaviour is always considered on an individual basis, including any identified SEND or wellbeing needs.

Why remove the traffic light system?

The new system is clearer, more consistent and better aligned with restorative practice and current behaviour research.

Will children get a fresh start?

Yes. After reflection and restorative work, children return to learning with a clean slate.
