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Dear Parent /Guardian,

Welcome back!

I hope that you all had a lovely, relaxing Christmas break. The children worked so hard during the Autumn term and the rest was well deserved. Spring term is set to be an exciting one!

Here are some key bits of new information and some reminders for this half term:

Attached is an overview of this terms first topic and subject content. Throughout this term, your child will be learning about the topic Ground-breaking Greeks.

- **PE:** This half term, the children will have PE on a **Tuesday** (with Bee Active) and they will have **Swimming on Fridays**. Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on Tuesdays. For girls with earrings, these must be either removed or covered for PE sessions. We cannot provide plasters to cover earrings, these must be brought in to school. Please note that PE days are likely to change each half term- but we will keep you updated!
- The children will go **swimming** every Friday of the Spring term, including the first week back. Children will need to bring appropriate swimming kit (see the letter previously sent).
- **Homework:** Homework will also be given out on Fridays and due back in on Wednesdays. This will include weekly spellings and a rotation of Maths and English. Year 5's topic homework for this half term is to create a piece of artwork for display which reflect their learning about the Ancient Greek culture. This might be a sculpture of a Greek God or Goddess, or a poster with some of their favourite facts from the term!
- **Reading:** Children should bring in their reading book(s) and yellow diary **every day**. We will continue to encourage children to read for pleasure as much as possible and there will be time in the school day for children to quiz on what they have read.
- Children need to bring in their own **water bottles** with them so they can have a drink throughout the school day.
