Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to invite you to watch your son/daughter perform at The Victoria Hall, Hanley in the Stoke School Sport Partnership annual dance event taking place on **20th March 2024**.

Our school is one of 63 primary and secondary schools from across Stoke-on-Trent taking part in the Stoke School Sport Partnerships annual dance event. Now in its 12th year this event brings together schools to showcase their inspirational dances. This year's theme is '**Lights, Camera, Action**'.

Tickets

A maximum of 2 tickets are available per performer at a cost of £9 each (under 18 months free but must sit on an adult's knee and have a 'babe in arms' ticket).

Step Free Access and Wheelchairs

There are designated wheelchair and Step Free* access seats/spaces available within the theatre. Please inform the school if you use a wheelchair and need a wheelchair space or you require a Step Free access seat so that the correct ticket can be allocated to you.

**Step Free access seats are for audience members who would have difficulty walking up/down steps to their seats.*

How to order your tickets

Tickets can only be ordered from the school by the **19th February 2024**. Please order your tickets via Parent Pay. If you require Wheelchair/step free access or will have a child under 18 months and require a 'babe in arms' ticket please inform us in the note section on Parent Pay, when purchasing your tickets. If you have any issues with Parent Pay or trouble in making payment, please contact the school office.

On the evening

Please bring your son/daughter to **The Victoria Hall** (Bagnall St, Hanley, Stoke-on-Trent ST1 3AD) on the night of the performance **between 5.30pm and 6pm** in their costume to the main foyer of the building. All performers will be seated in the stalls with their teachers, whilst parents/guardians with tickets will be seated in the circle and upper circle. Each school group will be allocated a meeting and collection point to meet their teacher on the night.

The performance will start at 6.30pm. We anticipated that the show would finish by approximately 8.00pm. If you are not watching the show, we ask that you arrive at the Victoria Hall by no later than 7.45pm in readiness to collect your child from their teacher once the show has finished.

We hope you will join us to support your child and our school in this event.
