Welcome Back!

We hope you have all had an amazing Easter break! Here are a few important bits of information for the upcoming half term:

Our new topic is 'School Days', where we will be learning all the history of our school, and the main key events in it's past to create a timeline. We will then begin to learn about life in the Victorian era, and how different being a child would have been compared to our lives today.

This half term we will be working on Athletics in **PE on a Tuesday**. Forest School will take place on a Wednesday afternoon (see separate letter). Children should arrive at school in their **PE kit on Tuesday and old clothes on Wednesday with a change of shoes**. Please ensure children are wearing the correct PE kit and earrings are covered if they can't be removed.

Homework will be given out on a **Friday** and is due back in on the **following Wednesday**. This will include a range of Maths, English and topic. Please continue to send your child with their reading book every day, this is extremely important to their learning as they read daily in school. Please read at home as much as possible with your child and sign their reading diary. The **Year 1 Phonics Check** will take place at the beginning of Summer 2 so anything you can do at home to help will give your child an advantage on passing. Practise words and sounds can be found on phonics play and completed electronically.
