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Dear Parents/Guardians,

Below are just a few notes about this half term:

- This half term, **PE** will be on a **Monday** afternoon and a **Tuesday** morning. This will be outside, weather permitting. Children should come to school in the correct PE kit (**Black shorts or jogging bottoms and a plain red or white T-shirt or T-shirt with the school logo on**).
- Homework will be given out on a Thursday and will be due in by the following Wednesday (There will be no homework the first week back).
- **Meet the teacher sessions** will be held in the Year 4 classroom on **Thursday 11th September** at 3:20pm and 5pm, where we will explore the topics for the year and I will be able to answer any questions that you may have.
