

What would you do in a medical emergency?

We do not like to think about or even imagine a medical emergency involving our children but if one did happen, would you know what to do?

OK, so you ring an ambulance, but what happens in the minutes before the paramedics arrive could **save your child's life.**

Goldenhill Primary Academy are running our first aid training session for parents on **Tuesday 1st October**. It will be presented by a qualified 1st aid trainer and will be aimed specifically at paediatric first aid.

The course will last for approximately 2 hours (3.30 – 5.30pm) and will cover:

- Assessment of the situation
- Dealing with an unresponsive casualty/ primary survey
- Infection control
- Bleeding - arterial, venous, capillary
- Resuscitation, adult, child and baby
- Recovery position
- choking
- AED functions
- Defibrillation procedures
- Safety measure

The fee for this training will be £18.00 per adult and includes refreshments. It will be held at school and will be very low key and informal whilst ensuring that vital training is delivered.

The Academy will run a crèche for this event free of charge.
