

Science

In Science, we will be starting our 'Animals including humans' topic. Children will learn to identify parts of the human body, and the senses that it uses. We will be learning to categorise animals and understand the differences between carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

PE

Maths

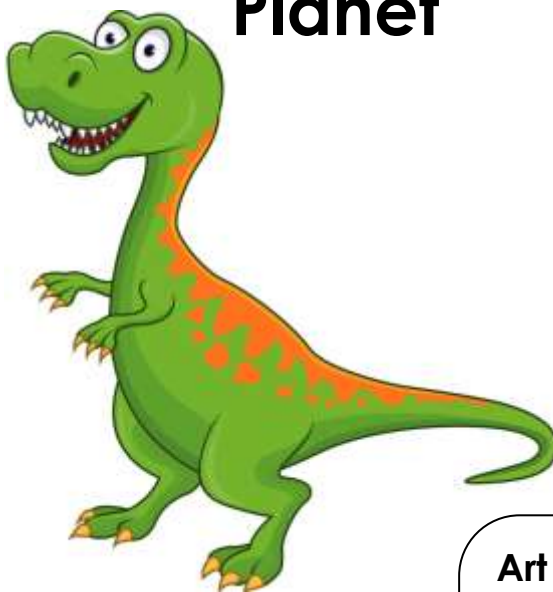
We will begin with looking at Addition and Subtraction (within 20) and then move on to continuing our understanding of place value, this time with number to 50.

English

Our class text is Cinderella. The children will be writing a retell the traditional story while adding in their own unique elements including sentence openers and adjectives. We will then move on to study The Land of the Dinosaurs, before writing our own non-chronological reports about dinosaurs.

Computing- In computing, children will be learning to create and use algorithms while navigating around a maze using the Purple Mash programme. Children will also be creating their own animated story books with images and voice recordings.

Dinosaur Planet



History

In History, we will be learning about the fossil discoveries of Mary Anning. Children will explore what happened to the dinosaurs, and the reasons for their extinction.

Geography

Children will develop their knowledge of the continents and oceans of the world. We will discuss animals at risk of extinction today and locate them on a world map.

RE

We will be asking what it means to belong to a faith community, with a particular focus for this unit, on Christianity.

Art

In Art the children will be making their own dinosaur eggs using malleable materials, such as dough and clay. We will explore ways of changing the shape of the materials by rolling, squeezing and pressing.

D&T

Children will make and design their own dinosaur puppets.
