

In Physical Development we will be learning:

Keeping healthy / safe in space
Rocket pathways. Planets and Stars - tracing constellations
Using tools to make rockets, space buggies, aliens etc, sewing, sticking, threading
Moving as if in space, Bedtime challenges - button up PJs, put on slippers, wash face etc.
Space inspired dances. Daily dough disco/ space dough

In Personal Social and Emotional Development we will be learning to:

Play cooperatively, taking turns. Take account of other's ideas, Show sensitivity
Form positive relationships with adults and other children, Confident to try new activities
Confident to speak in small group - talk about ideas and choose resources, Know and say when they do and don't need help, Talk about they and others show feelings
Space / Bedtime - role play, Tell me something happy before I go to sleep by Joyce Dunbar - linked to P4C, It's a small world - dark space small world, Being alone / scared link to P4C

In Expressive Arts and Design we will be exploring :

Sing songs, make music and dance linked to Space, Lullabies, Dreams - Just Imagine!
I and the Village by Chagall, Make a sleepy 'thing', The Lost Stars by Hannah Cumming - provide with lots of shiny materials to make star mobiles, Deep Space - swirly paint patterns, Make constellations using tea lights
Use range of materials, tools, techniques.
Experiment with colour, design, texture, form and function.
Represent ideas, thoughts and feelings through DT, art, music, dance role play and stories

In Maths we will be learning:

Counting and reading numbers
Adding and Subtracting
Shape and space
Reasoning
Measures, including time
Money and 'real life' problems



In Communication and Language we will be learning:

Manners
Show & Tell
Circle games
Stories -
Listen in range of situations
Anticipating key events
Respond appropriately
Follow instructions
Ask how and why questions
Use past, present and future tense
Develop own narrative

In Understanding the World we will be learning about:

Knowledge about Space travel, the universe, gravity changes, hot / cold / fir / ice, magnetism, floating / sinking, melting, freezing, Life on the moon, Binoculars and Telescopes
