Year Three Educational Visit Autumn Term 2019

Dear Parent / Guardian,

Year Three will be visiting Liverpool World Museum on Thursday 17th October as part of our Gods and Mortals topic. We will be learning all about ancient Greece and its myths and monsters through two exciting workshops, one in the morning and one in the afternoon:

a.m. Myths and Monsters

In this session, pupils will be introduced to the principal gods, goddesses and heroes of Greek legend. They will discover that much like humans today they had fierce family feuds, travelled abroad on bold adventures, and celebrated their successes with big parties! Pupils will also discover some of the great Greek heroes that battled with fearsome monsters and composite creatures. The session is supported by a variety of replica props, costumes, artistic interpretations and digital resources. Pupils will be encouraged to take part in dressing up, role-play and a team game.

p.m. Discover Ancient Greece

During the workshop pupils will be able to touch artefacts such as sculptures of gods and goddesses, a Spartan shield, a bronze sword, pottery and terracotta animal figurines that were used as toys. Students will be able to imagine the person who carefully made them and think about why they were so important to the ancient Greek people over 2500 years ago. After an initial introduction by a member of the museum staff, the group will be divided into four smaller groups to take on the role of archaeologists as they handle and discuss the evidence revealed by the museum's artefacts

We have also booked a room in the museum for a picnic lunch. The children will need to bring a packed lunch in a disposable container or bag (no lunch boxes or fizzy drinks please). They will need to wear their school uniform for the visit. The children will return to school before the end of the school day.
