

Science

In Science, we will be learning all about seasonal changes which take place between winter and spring. We will measure the weather in a range of ways, using specialist equipment such as a rain gauge. We will learn about why certain animals and plants thrive at certain times of year, and will begin to understand the idea of day length.

DT

In DT, children will be creating their own windmill structure using a range of materials.

PE

PE this half term will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Our topics are invasion games and sending and receiving.

Maths

We will continue to develop our understanding of number and place value within 20, learning about tens and ones, comparing and ordering numbers and the number line. We will then move on to addition and subtraction, working with number to 20 and develop our fluency with addition and subtraction facts. Then the children return to number, but expand their understanding to numbers within 50.

Computing

Children will use Purple Mash to create their own animated stories, and group and sort information. We will also begin to understand coding using Bee Bots.

Bright Lights Big City



English

Our first key text is The Lion Inside, a journey story about a lion and a mouse. During this text we will be writing letters, descriptions and a story retell changing one of the characters. Our second text is The Curious Case of the Missing Mammoth and we will be writing diary entries, recounts, posters and poems. Throughout the term, we will be focusing on accurate sentence construction, er, est and ed suffixes, conjunctions and the use of exclamation and question marks and adjectives.

Art

In Art we will learn all about the work of Stephen Wiltshire, and his special talent of drawing from memory. We will use his techniques to draw some famous landmarks of London. We will also be making our mark and learning to draw from observation. Then we will move onto painting where we will learn to mix colours and create different shades.

RE

In our RE unit, we will learn all about Judaism. We ask the question, who is Jewish and how do they live? We learn about special events and traditions in the Jewish calendar and compare this with what we know about Christianity.

History

In History, we will learn about the events of the Great Fire of London, why they happened, how they could have been prevented, and the impact that this has had on London today.

Geography

We will learn about the 4 countries of the UK, and their capital cities focusing mainly on London. We will spot human and physical geographical features, and learn about compass directions. We also compare London to Malaysia's capital city Kuala Lumpur.
