

Science

In Science, we will be completing a unit all animals and humans. We will firstly learn about the body parts of humans, before exploring the 5 senses and how they help us to experience the world. The children will need to use their senses during our science investigation. We will then learn about animal body parts, and sort animals accordingly.

Computing

Children will use Purple Mash to create their own animated stories, then we will learn all about coding.

History

In History, children will be learning all about Queen Elizabeth II. We will also learn about the events of the Great Fire of London, why they happened, how they could have been prevented, and the impact that this has had on London today. We will be comparing today's firefighting to the tools London would have had back then!

Geography

The children will learn about the 4 countries of the UK, and their capital cities. We will spot human and physical geographical features, and learn about compass directions.

PE

PE this half term will be on Mondays and Tuesdays. We will have health related education on Mondays, and become Sports Explorers on Tuesdays- both sessions with Bee Active.

RE

In our RE unit, we will learn all about friendship. The children will learn to retell some religious stories of friendship and explain how some of the characters from the stories were good friends.

Maths

We will continue to develop our understanding of number and place value within 20. We will then move on to addition and subtraction, working with number to 20. Then the children return to number, but expand their understanding to numbers within 50.

DT

In DT, children will be creating their own London Bus or Taxi when we learn about using wheels and axles.

English

During this term, the children will retell the story of Katie in London. We will describe characters and settings from the story. Then, we will move on to the Great Fire of London, when we will write recounts from the perspective of Samuel Pepys and some amazing fire poetry, full of exciting adjectives.

Art

In Art we will learn all about the work of Stephen Wiltshire, and his special talent of drawing from memory. We will use his techniques to draw some famous landmarks of London.
