On April 12<sup>th</sup> we are hosting our annual Easter Bonnet and Decorate an Egg Competitions. The Easter bonnet competition is open to Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Decorating an egg competition is open to Years 3,4,5 and 6.

### Easter Bonnet Competition

Each child in **Nursery, Reception, Year 1 & 2** are welcome to create an Easter bonnet. Entry to the competition is free and two winners will be chosen from each class by an independent judge during the school day.

Dependent upon the weather, there will be a bonnet parade around the playground by each class at 9.15a.m. Parents/Guardians of children in these classes are very welcome to join us and watch the parade. If the weather is inclement the parade will take place a class at a time in the school hall. Parents/Guardians will be welcome into the hall to watch their child's class parade.

Please note; due to space restrictions bonnets are to be brought into school on April 12<sup>th</sup> only.

### Decorate an Egg Competition

Each child in **Years 3,4,5 & 6** are welcome to decorate an egg in a theme of their choice. Entry to the competition is free and two winners will be chosen from each class by an independent judge during the school day.

Each decorated egg will be placed on display in the entrance foyer for the day.

Please note; due to space restrictions decorated eggs may only be brought into school on April 12<sup>th</sup>. The decorated eggs must be collected at the end of the school day.

Enjoy creating your bonnet or decorated egg, we are looking forward to seeing all your wonderful creations. For each competition the judge will be looking for the following criteria to establish the winners:

- Child input into the creation
- Unusual ideas
