Next half term as part of our 'Long Ago' topic I have organised an educational visit to Brampton Museum in Newcastle. This will be a full day workshop experience (10am-2.30pm) where the children become immersed in a storybook and go on a time travelling adventure to the Victorian period, meet characters from the storybook, use Expressive Arts and Design skills to investigate materials and invent a new toy, then solve the mystery of the missing toys and explore our museum.

This visit will take place on February 3rd 2025. We will leave school at 9.15 and return by the end of the school day.

The cost of the trip is £16.80 child which covers the cost of coach travel and the workshop. This can be paid on Parent Pay and can be paid in instalments or in one lump sum. If we don't receive enough contributions towards the trip we reserve the right to cancel the event. We ask that all payments are made by January 31st 2025.

As all the children receive a school meal they can have a packed lunch prepared by the kitchen staff or, if you prefer, you may send them with a packed lunch. Please indicate below for catering purposes. I would like the children in a full school uniform please including a warm coat.
